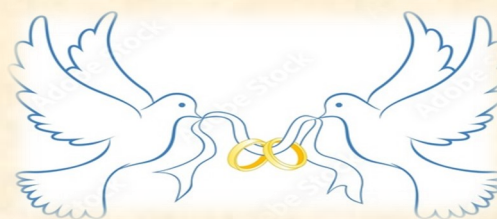

Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

“Remove the wooden beam from your eye first, then you will see clearly to remove the splinter in your brother’s [sister’s] eye.” The scriptures these last few weeks call for some self-examination and serious changes in our thinking and attitude.
